



7th Grade Bible

In seventh grade Bible students examine the New Testament from the birth of Christ through the life of the early church. Students complete a thorough research paper on one New Testament letter. Special attention is given to helping students develop their own ability to search and understand the Bible, and helping them to make personal applications regarding their own lifestyle choices.
