

EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER TEACHER JOB DESCRIPTION

Infant Toddler Center

The person selected for this position will be responsible for the general supervision and management of a class of children between the ages of 3 months to 2.9 years old for the Infant/Toddler Center.

Spiritual:

The person selected for this position will be someone who believes in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, has yielded and committed their life to doing His will. They must have the Fruit of the Spirit (as written in Galatians 5:22-23) bearing witness in their life.

Qualifications:

Has received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Regular attender or member at a Bible-believing church.

Personal behavior on and off school grounds should reflect Biblical standards.

The person selected for this position must be professionally prepared as a teacher of young children, especially in the field of Early Childhood Education & Development meeting the requirements of the state licensing agency. A minimum of 12 Early Childhood Education Units. (Classes must include Child Development, Child, Family, Community, 2 curriculum classes, and Infant/Toddler class.) Also desirable is a current Infant/Child CPR and First Aid Certification Card. A minimum of one year's experience in a Child Care Center is required. Further education in Early Childhood Education is needed to maintain our Accreditation and is encouraged. This person must be a sensitive and mature individual who is able to relate well to both children and adults. This person must also be a sharing and cooperative individual with other staff members as we all put forth a team effort in every area of the working day.
