11-month (August-June) and 12-month (July-June) payment plans are also available, as well as the option to pay in full.

TUITION PAYMENTS - A late fee of \$25.00 will be charged for all tuition amounts that are past due. Any account delinquent more than 30 days may result in the student being withheld from classes until the account is brought current.

There is a minimum tuition commitment of two quarters for all new families.

Tuition includes textbooks. Additional fees apply for field trips, uniforms, etc. Chromebooks are required for grades 6-12.

All tuition, extended care fees, field trips and other expenses are invoiced and paid through FACTS, a Nelnet company. Annual management fees for FACTS are paid by the school for one account per family. Additional accounts may be purchased for students with multiple family payers.
